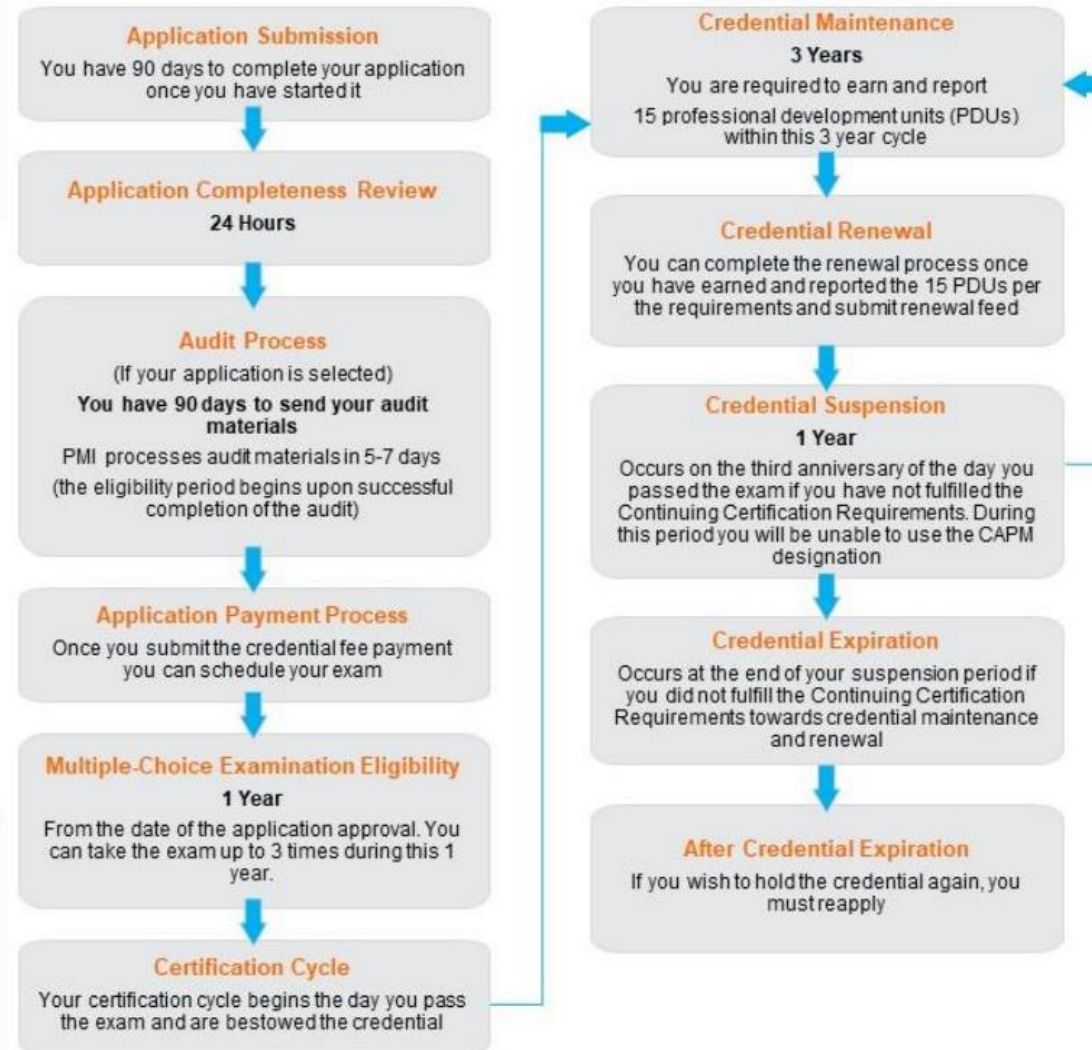
Traditional View of Project Management

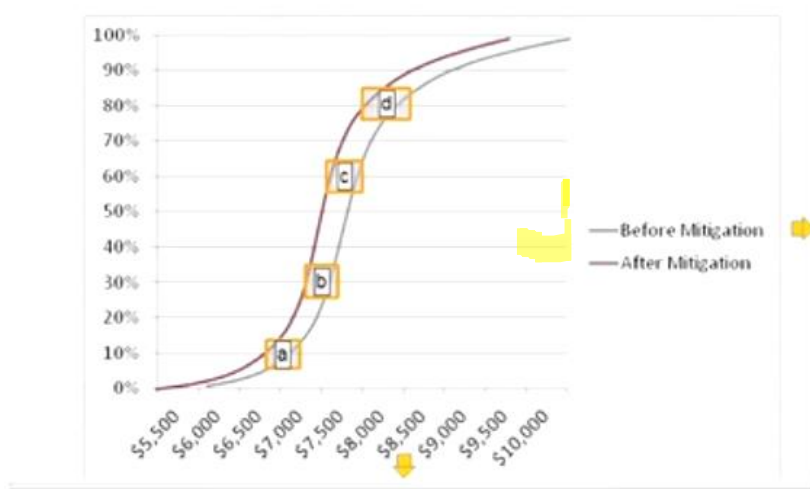

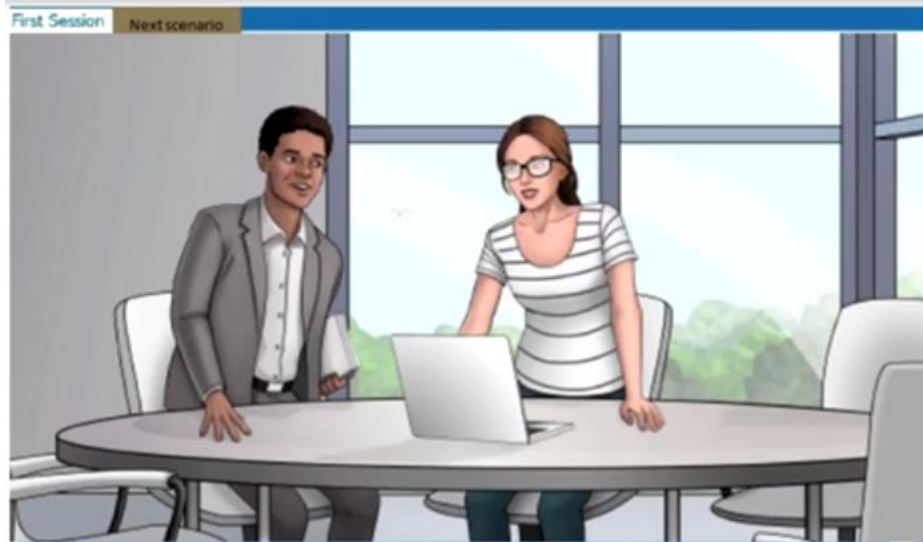

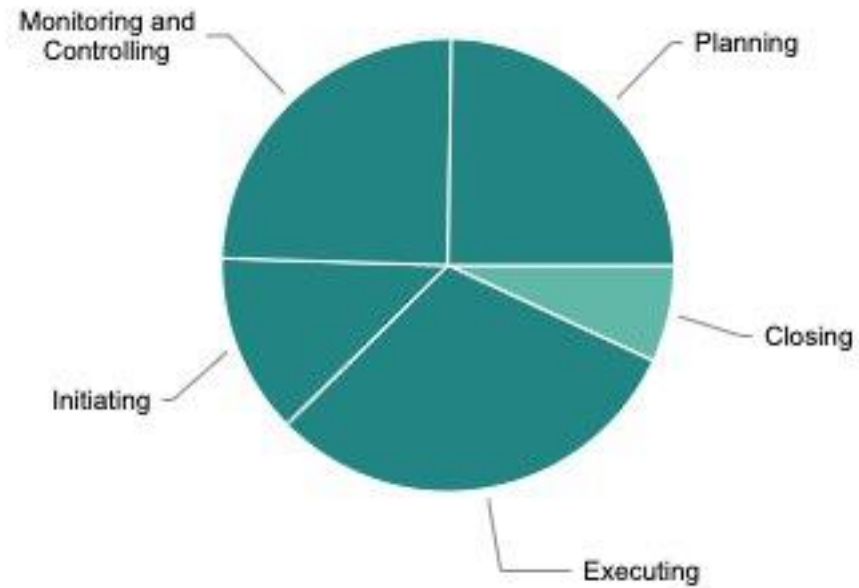
